Situated on the shores of River Bagmati is another major tourist site of Kathmandu. The Pashupatinath Temple, built in 5th century, is the oldest Hindu temple in the city and belongs to national deity, Lord Pashupatinath. Apart from exploring these places of interest in Kathmandu, travelers can also enjoy shopping in traditional market. The city is especially popular for antique items and traditional handicrafts goods like Tibetan carpets, scroll paintings, Terai baskets and rice paper.

Besides its own attractions, Kathmandu city also acts as a perfect gateway for excursions to various other beautiful regions of Nepal. Explore these charming places while enjoying your Kathmandu holidays. One among them is "Royal Chitwan National Park". It is the oldest national park in the country and is situated in Tarai lowlands.
