Situated on Cart Mackenjie Road, it is an ancient temple, about 6 kms from Mussoorie. You can capture a charming view of Mussoorie and Doon Valley together. You would not feel bereft of God

Mussoorie Lake

6 kms from Mussoorie, situated on Mussoorie - Dehradun road, it is a recently developed picnic spot full of delight that could be a part of hill station fun like Mussoorie tourism.
