Euston Station is located in the London Borough of Camden, nearby to popular destinations Russell Square, Camden Town and Kings Cross St Pancras. This main Network Rail terminus was London's first inner-city railway station that provided journeys from London to other destinations throughout the country. Originally opened in 1837 with only two platforms, it now has 18 platforms serving destinations all across the UK. Euston Station is connected to the London Underground system, so there are connections on the Northern and Victoria line. There are a number of bus routes that are situated out the front of the station, providing alternative onward travel options. Taxis in Euston line up outside the main entrance and exit too, so you can be sure to hail a ride to your final destination. For those that are waiting to take a train from Euston to their chosen destination, there is a number of outlets to wait in. Whether you are doing so because you are a tad early for the train or because delays have held you up, there is a pub, cafes and shops to while away the time.

Many people that use the cross-railway are commuters, travelling long distances for work and business matters. With Euston Station being one of the largest hubs for transport across the lengths and breadths of the UK, many people rely on this transportation. Destinations from Euston include the West Midlands, the North West, Wales, Scotland and the South. Euston rail travel is a reliable and fast way to keep connected with the rest of the UK. Euston Station minicabs provide a relied upon mode of transport by commuters to take them to business offices located nearby.
