Estepona City is located at the western coast of Spain with a distinction; its natural beauty flows easily throughout the coast with plenty of Spanish firs. Its rich culture stemmed from the presence of Phoenicians, Arabs and Romans whose influence exists until today.

Estepona has become a very popular holiday destination with its multiple magnificent beaches that come with quantity facilities and services. Many tourists flock to Estepona to enjoy the sun and sand that can be found in various parts of the coast. There are many choices of wonderful beaches in Estepona.

La Rada beach

The la Rada beach is located opposite an urban hull which was recently regenerated. This lovely beach boasts of many beach sports and facilities to allow a tourist to spend a full day frolicking in the sun and sea. The beach alone stretches 2300 meters for a great run around.

El Cristo beach

The El Cristo beach is 1300 meters long which is also located near the urban hull; it is slightly hidden away from the center making it accessible to Estepona's sports port. One of the interesting pieces at this beach spot is a regenerated cove which forms a sheltered zone from strong winds.

Punta de Plata beach

This is one of the longest beaches in Estepona; it is about 4000 meters long with quality and exclusive services. It is an urbanized beach with many locals plying it throughout the week.

Other beaches that can be enjoyed with a smaller crowd include Casasola, Bella, Saldillo, Costa Natural, Arroyo de los Caños, Bahía Dorada, Arroyo Baquero and La Galera.

Prominent Monuments

Tourists to Estepona will also enjoy visiting Virgin of the Remedies Church, Clock Tower, Marquess of Mondájar palaces and other exciting archaeological discoveries from the Roman era.

Natural Wonders

Nature lovers will enjoy Los Reales at the Sierra Bermeja for some lovely mountain landscapes and exquisite flora and fauna. The Spanish fir, pine groves, blockheads, coscojas and junipers are some of the natural forest flora abounding here with Moorish gorse, thin piorno, rosemary, palmetto and endemismos plants at the high mountains.

The delightful fauna found here include the roe-deer, wild goat, otter, wildcat and mongoose. Bird watchers will be delightful with the variety of species like the worn eagle, sparrow-hawk, tawny vulture and real owls. Amphibians and reptiles thrive in abundance due to the rich environment for their living like the salamander, common toad, leprous tortoise, snakes and eslizán.

Many parks have been reserved to cater to this exotic wildlife for their preservation and convenient viewing of tourists and locals.
