The commercial city of Johannesburg apart from being a hub of diamond and gold business, boasts of rich historical heritage that has been well preserved in its old townships, virtual cities, museums, art galleries and landmarks. Its most popular destinations with historical significance are The Gold Reef City, The Soweto, The Museum Africa, the Apartheid Museum, The South African National Museum of Military History, the Johannesburg Art Gallery, The Fort at Constitution Hill, Constitutional Court, Gandhi Square, Nelson Mandela Square etc. The travelers of Flights to Johannesburg should explore these destinations to the fullest.

The Gold Reef City situated in Johannesburg is a virtual city depicting the look of the place during the gold rush period of the late 19th century. It is built on an old gold mine and portrays the golden era of the city in a very elaborate way. Also the Soweto, acronym for South Western Townships that is located near the mining belt of the city depicts the mining industry of the past. A visit to these townships using cheap flights to Johannesburg will let one experience the golden heritage of the city from close quarters.

The Museum Africa earlier called Africana Museum portrays the African history and material culture. It was established in 1993 and a year later in 1994 was renamed as MuseuMAfricA. The museum symbolizes the establishment of democracy and end of apartheid during the 20th century. On the other hand The South African National War Museum displays relics pertaining to the involvement of the country during the Second World War. The Johannesburg flights are used by tourists to visit these destinations.

The Johannesburg Art Gallery displays art collections belonging to different centuries starting from the 15th century. The paintings pertain to different styles ranging from Dutch, British, European, South African, contemporary to local and international. The Constitution Hill is home to a fort that was used as a prison till 1983. Social reformers like Nelson Mandela and Mahatma Gandhi were imprisoned here. At present the Constitutional Court of South Africa is situated here. The tourists availing the direct flights to Johannesburg travel services visit the court building which displays over 200 contemporary artworks of well known artists like Gerard Sekoto, William Kentridge, and Cecil Skotnes.

Famous landmarks such as The Gandhi Square and The Nelson Mandela Square are tributes to the social reformers and world leaders- Mahatma Gandhi and Nelson Mandela. The Gandhi Square is a plaza situated in the Central Business District of Johannesburg and consists of many shops. The Nelson Mandela Square consists of a statue of the former President of south Africa- Mr. Nelson Mandela. The landmark signifies the end of apartheid and establishment of democracy in South Africa. The visitors using Johannesburg travel tips visit the above mentioned historical destinations.
