A Canadian visa is needed for you to live and work in Canada. There are a number of visa that can lead to permanent residence. To be eligible to enter Canada you will need the following Canadian visa:

• Working holiday visa allows young people between the ages of 18 to 35 years from eligible countries to work for six months for one employer and explore Canada for 12 months.

• Work visa allows highly skilled workers with skills to live and work in Canada as permanent residents.

• Travel visa is for tourists and business people who wish to travel to Canada for a short time.

• Business visa is for individuals seeking to establish or invest in a business which will create growth to the economy of Canada.

• Citizenship is for those who have maintained their permanent residents or people with ties to Canada to become Canadian citizens.

• Family visa helps to reunite family members living abroad with their Canadian family.

• Temporary work visa is designed to fill Labour shortages by granting workers with specific skills that are in demand in Canada a chance to work.

• Student visa allow international students to study at one of the world-class schools, universities, colleges in Canada.

To study in Canada you will need to have a study permit. If you want to extend your stay in Canada you must complete the application to change the conditions to extend your study permit. You should renew your permit 30 days before your visa expires. To be eligible for a study permit Canada you must have been accepted by a school, college, university or other Canadian institution, you have to provide proof of sufficient funds to pay for your tuition, living expenses for you and any accompanying family members, have no criminal records, be in good health and prove that you will leave Canada once you complete your studies.

If you lose your permit you should replace it by applying and paying a fee. The permit has the following condition that tell you which institution you can study, if you are allowed to work in Canada, when you must leave, if your travel within Canada is restricted and whether you need to report for a medical examination or treatment. Your spouse and dependant children are allowed to accompany you to Canada. They are allowed to work and study in Canada and leave as the main applicant is leaving.
