Jaipur - Jaipur is the capital of Rajasthan state, popularly known as pink city. It is the first planned city of India and it is also one of the cities of India's famous golden triangle tour. Jaipur is the most visited city by tourists in the state and famous for its grand forts and palaces. Mount Abu - Mount Abu is the only hill station in Rajasthan and it is situated on a 1,219 meters high rock plateau of the Aravalli hills.
