This editor is extremely safe and offers great tools even to compress images that you have exported from your digital camera.

2. Adobe Photoshop

One of the most popular image editor and compressor tools available, it has excellent features such as "save for web" functions which allow developers to create web optimized versions of images which lightens the images without compromising on the quality of the image.

3. Adobe Fireworks

This software offers the unique capability of integrating bitmap and vector elements into a single file. It creates some very good quality compressed images that are sufficient for use on the internet.

4. Image Magi-ck

This is a Linux based command line tool where you can use a range of commands in your PHP coding scripts to enable you to compress your image using 8% quality.

Avoid Making these Mistakes

1. A common mistake developers tend to make is that they scale down their images using a website creation program and not an image editing program.
2. This will simply result in a smaller image with the same size of the file.
3. Making using of a quality image editing program will make sure that your size also reduces

without hampering the quality of the image file.

When you are resizing your image to a smaller size, you are not actually working on the dimensions of an image; you are working towards making it lighter, so that it loads faster when a user visits your website. Make sure you employ a well known editor program and give you effective and quality results.
