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In today's demanding embedded environment, Java Platform, Standard Edition (Java SE) allow to develop Java applications on desktop or servers. As knows Java allows RICH user interface, portability and best of all is the security for today's world.

Drag and Drop API was one of the several APIs brought by JAVA SE 6, which allowed extending TransfereSupport class to support Swing application. This gave developers an easy break through to build live feedback into their controls.

Beginning of JAVA SE 6 release Swing application was not introduced, significantly improved JTable by adding API for sort and filtering contents of table. This APIs allows creating custom data types for filter and sorting.

JAVA SE 6 came up with SwingWorker utility class makes background tasks much simpler. This lets allow progress feedback to User Interface on Swing Event thread on background thread by SwingWorker spawns.

An implementation of Java Virtual Machine (JVM) specification by JVM interprets complied Java binary code (called bytecode) which executes java instructions. Java allows application to run on any platform that was the curiosity in developing on Java, without rewritten or recompiled on separate platform.

Languages that are used to produce software that runs on the Java Virtual Machine. Some of these languages are interpreted by a Java Program, and some are complied with Java bytecode and JIT to improve performance. Initial design of Java Virtual Machine is to support only Java Programming languages, more languages were adapted run on Java platform.
