The coins are usually made up of 24 karat versions of state quarter.

You can collect the set of coins yearly or you can select a particular year that means for you. You can buy a set of coins for under \$10 from the year of 1992. Bear in mind you could buy higher priced set of coins if they are unopened unlike in opened package coin but what makes it interesting is that you do not know what type of coin you bought since they are unopened.
