Laser hair removal is most effective for people who have light skin and dark hair. It typically takes several laser hair removal treatments to provide an extended hair-free period. Periodic maintenance treatments may be needed as well. One of the most important things to avoid doing after any surgery is applying any kind of facial creams, ointments, cleansers, bleaching agents, cold creams, lotions, sprays, beauty products such as whiteners, etc. without consulting your surgeon. Moreover, the skin must not be exposed to any irritants, harsh chemical agent, gases, extremely harsh or extended durations of sunlight. Therefore, the skin must be carefully and gently moistened and wiped and not rigorously, harshly.

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
