If a restaurant chair is broken you would just order some more to replace it, but because a booth is a greater investment, some restaurant owners find it is more cost effective to fix a broken booth instead of replacing it. The most common issue with restaurant booths are tears in the vinyl. This problem can be mitigated by making sure you purchase restaurant booths with quality vinyl upholstery. The actual wooden frame of the booth is very durable so any restaurant owner should make sure to ask questions about the source and quality of the vinyl when purchasing booths. Being diligent in this aspect will save money in the long run because reupholstering a restaurant booth can be time consuming and expensive.

Most restaurants decide to use a combination of both restaurant booths and restaurant chairs. A typical dining room will have booths around the sides of the room and corners, and chairs in the middle of the room. This gives a combination of seating space and privacy. However, this is not for all restaurants. A small mom and pop restaurant may opt for restaurant chairs only because they are not as concerned with a classy private atmosphere. On the other hand, most high end restaurants will have some Restaurant booths as part of their seating.
