Browser

You have to have a browser to visit any of your favorite websites. Also, there are several web browsers available on the internet. Keyword Density

Keyword density is the percentage of the targeted keywords used in an article or a web page. You can calculate the keyword density of a keyword by dividing the number of times you used your targeted keywords by the total words used and multiply by hundred. So, if you have mentioned your targeted keyword 5 times in a total text of 500 words, the keyword density would be 1%.

Monetize

Monetizing is another popular term in the web Glossary. Any product or service offered online to make money is termed as monetizing. So, whether you use your website to show an ad or write articles or content for different individuals, the whole practice will be termed as monetizing. Also, e-mail marketing has become a popular monetizing technique for most moms around the world.
