The problem-list is endless; let's target the website load or display issue that puzzles you every now and then. For those looking for At&T Wireless Support service, can also rely on the solution.

Don't you find the website display appropriate? Wait, analyze & interpret the message of your web browser. There can be different situations: (a) you may get warning unresponsive script, (b) images can be blocked, (c) issues can be with the audio and video features, (d) unable to load the website, or it may show a spinning wheel and never finish loading, or (e) you may get errors while getting logged in to a website.

Unresponsive script may stem up due to the activities of any installed security product owing to its cookies tracking feature. Sometimes, you can try by letting the script run longer. Configure the browser to let the script run longer. In the about:config page, search for the preference dom.max_script_run_time. Right-click on it and choose Reset.

Images are not working right on your website? Possible causes are: (a) browser settings issues, (b) cookies and cache, (c) inappropriate security software settings, and (d) faulty Windows settings. Accordingly, you can find the way out to fix problems, and the troubleshooting would differ as per the type of browser, Windows versions and security software type or nature.

Absence of audio and video feature with web content translates that a required plugin for the installed media player is missing, outdated, blocked, in conflict with another plugin or extension, or the content may be blocked for some reason. To fix such issues, you can install or update plugins or disable or remove the conflicting one. Depending upon the media player type, install or update the desired plug-ins (Flash plugin, Java plugin, Silverlight plugin, Windows Media Player plugin, QuickTime plugin, etc.) that can support wide range of media formats like asf, .asx, .wm, .wma, .wax, .wmp, .wmv, .wvx. and more.

A few common troubleshooting steps for resolving At&T Internet issues include: (a) Restart your computer, (b) Clear your cookies and cache, (c) Update your plugins, (d) Restart browser in Safe Mode, (e) Troubleshoot your plugins, (f) Reset browser settings, (g) Reinstall Firefox, and (h) Make a new profile, (i) check for conflicts with your Internet security software, (j) Scan your system for viruses and spyware and (k) Check your hard drive for errors.
