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What is “Blue Screen of Death” also commonly referred as Blue-Screen error? Ask anybody with a Dell PC, and you will get overwhelming replies. Don’t abuse your Dell machine. An evaluation reveals that software errors in device drivers are the probable reasons. In NT-based Windows systems poorly-written device drivers and in the Windows 9 x family of operating systems incompatible DLL driver files or bugs are responsible for the cause. Hardware faults are limited, and happen when there is slip with the RAM or power supply. The error stops the system resources to respond to the Windows files, and the screen displays desired information, usually in white fonts over a blue-screen, for diagnostic purposes. There can be different instances such as: Windows detecting an error it cannot recover from without losing data, Windows detects that critical OS data has become corrupted, Windows detects that hardware has failed in a non-recoverable fashion.

Numeric value accompanied with the error is an indication of the nature of problems, and before going with tech support, you can try to overcome the issues on your own. Stop 0x000000ED (UNMOUNTABLE_BOOT_VOLUME) or

Stop 0x0000007B (INACCESSIBLE_BOOT_DEVICE)

it means that system has loaded NTLDR and transferred control of the startup process to NTOSKRNL, and the latter is confused.

Hence, troubleshooting involves finding the exact reason that why the Windows kernel is confused and fix the cause of the confusion. If it has happened due to fault in system BIOS then you can try by toggling from ATA to AHCI mode (or vice versa). Try changing the RAID settings back to “Autodetect” if you think this is the probable cause. Execute the built-in hardware diagnostics tool and scan the system resources to find associated errors. Integrated Windows recovery console can also check all hard-drive partitions to know about potential fault.

Though, your Dell PC or laptop comes with a warranty period, but there can’t be a restriction on the error. The least advantage calling Dell Help-desk is that you don’t have to pay for the hardware related faults, as that is subject to free replacement or repair. However, if the problem is software related then you are supposed to pay for the same.
