These anti-slip conditioners contain special additives that make them safe even when the floor is wet.

As earlier said, when compared to the cost of installing natural floorings they are inexpensive. Usually the price is dependent on the level of polishing that is required. Costs would go up if you're planning to apply other techniques such as decorative concrete or acid staining. Prices also vary according to the area and the contractor.
