Consider the underside of the bed frames if it has sufficient space for a box spring mattress to go under the kid's mattress or if the beds have wooden supports for the mattress to sit on.

Be sure that the beds have plenty of room at the bottom bunk for the kids to sit on comfortably. This will likely also help prevent the kids from always playing on the top bunk where it can be more unsafe.

The bunk bed needs to have a safety sticker that lists the safety tips for the bed. Make sure you know if the bed is made of robust and fine quality materials. A good way to test is if you attempt to shake the bed and see how it reacts. A bunk bed made of solid wood is sturdy compared to a bed constructed from particle board.

Determine if the corners and edges on the bunk beds are smooth and rounded. If this is not the case, blunt and sharp edges can cause bruises and bumps. Needless to say you will not want this to happen especially to kids.

The ladder or stair of the bunk bed should be tightly connected and wide enough for your kid to climb. Check if the bunk beds have guardrails and these should not be removed by kids. As a safety function, the guardrails can prevent your children from to fall out of the bed.
