Additionally, according to the Pennsylvania Dram Shop Statute and the Social Host Law, the person, or social host, who served alcohol to the drunk driver, can be held responsible in certain cases besides the driver himself. If alcohol has been served to a person who was either visibly intoxicated or a minor, then it strengthens your case.

The Dram Shop Statute plays a critical role in Pennsylvania as sometimes the intoxicated driver is not solely held responsible for the damages he or she might cause. Under this law, a business or another person who serves alcohol to a visibly intoxicated person is also legally accountable for the loss to life or property that the person subsequently causes. This law also applies when one gives alcohol to a minor, serves alcohol after an establishment closes, or serves alcohol without a valid license.
