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The rare, but often lethal, disease known as mesothelioma has claimed many lives throughout the years. According to statistics, about 14 deaths per million are recorded per year. However, this number could be much higher because not all mesothelioma deaths are properly diagnosed. In addition, other cases were misdiagnosed as lung cancer, or other cancer of no known origin.

Between 1999 and 2005, 18,068 Americans died of mesothelioma, according to www.mesotheliomaweb.org.

The Centers for Disease Control's National Institute of Occupational Safety & Health, disclosed that the industries that are most likely to be affected by mesothelioma are boat building and repairing, industrial and miscellaneous chemicals, petroleum refining and electric light and power.

It is vital that people with history of asbestos exposure to be cautious and observe themselves for the slightest symptoms. If you think you were exposed to products with asbestos, and you observe certain symptoms, consult a physician immediately. Common symptoms include breathing difficulty and heaviness in the chest area due to fluid buildup.

Being diagnosed with mesothelioma is not only depressing; it is also a financial catastrophe. Medical bills and other expenses related to treatment can be devastating. There are, however, legal options that are available for mesothelioma patients. If you are a victim, contact a mesothelioma lawyer immediately.

In May 2012, a jury awarded \$2.4 million to the family of Hannibal "Scottie" Saldibar, who died in January 2010 after being diagnosed with mesothelioma nine months before. Mr. Saldibar was a tile setter for 30 years at Tile Council of North America, Inc.

Several large companies have filed for bankruptcy protection to resolve thousands and thousands of claims and lawsuits arising from asbestos exposure. Among them are Armstrong World Industries, ASARCO, Celotex Corporation, E.J. Bartells, Federalâ€Mogul Corporation, Fuller Austin Insulation Co., Global Technologies (GIT), Johnsâ€Manville Corporation, North American Refractories Co., Owensâ€Corning, USG Corporation and W.R. Grace.

Since some claimants affected by mesothelioma are too weak to fight their battle, or were no longer available to have their day in court, family members and organizations are fighting for them. If you knew family members, who were exposed to asbestos and exhibited mesothelioma symptoms
