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Sometimes accidentally some very important files on your PC may be erased by yourself or sometimes you remove them and then wish that you simply had not. The most common thing in the two cases you would like to know is how to get back deleted files from your Recycle Bin?

As to this question, the response relies upon the time you erased the files. If you deleted them merely several hours or a few days, then it is really quite simple to get back deleted files. But if you've erased the files several weeks ago, then it is just a little difficult. Anyway, here I will illustrate some tips about how to get back deleted files.

Actually the files you removed by using delete option would go to the Recycle Bin. In this case just using restore option would help you recover this erased file. While, for the files you deleted from the Recycle Bin or by using the shortcut key combination of shift delete, the reference to the erased file or the address by which the file is located on the hard disk is totally removed. Also, the area occupied by that file is available for reuse by new files. But once the space is taken up by new files it might be impossible to restore that old erased file. That is to say, as long as the space is not occupied by new files, then there are chances to restore data.

As I mentioned earlier, if you need a certain file back, first please ensure that you don't save anything on your PC until you have retrieved the erased file, then it is recovery. For Mac, there is timeline utility pre-installed which is easy to run. But if it does not work, well, the best way to help you deal with such an issue is to use external file recovery software. Of course, you will find free and compensated software available on the Internet, however, you had better choose one which is simple to use and retrieve your files effectively.

In fact, the method to retrieve files is pretty much the same. For Vista, a 3rd party program would be the best choice, since it does not have function like timeline. So you ought to find a better one for safe file retrieval.

In brief, for erased files recovery, the key factor would be to not save anything on your PC till you've got your erased file back. If the area is overwritten, it is impossible to retrieve your file or recover deleted photos.

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
